Driving Standards Complaint Procedure

All incidents resulting in contact between two vehicles must be reported to the DSO, preferably with video evidence from the driver of the vehicle making the complaint.

The incident must be reported as soon as practicable after the completion of the race, qualifying, or official practice.

A discussion between the drivers and the DSO will take place in an area with access to video playback facilities to determine what further steps, if any are warranted.

These discussions will be solely between the parties concerned and no other persons will be permitted to enter the area until conclusive evidence is shown to either proceed the matter to the race stewards and the QLD Production Cars Committee, or end the matter there.

Should the stewards at the meeting initiate a meeting between the parties the DSO will attend that meeting with the drivers, after first viewing video evidence (if available) and discussing the incident with the drivers.

As our aim is always to have a safe and competitive meeting, any unsafe interactions between vehicles will be dealt with and may lead to exclusion from the event.
